We knock on doors year round and help people with problems (casework). We attend the **Lansdowne** and **Leverton Tenants and Residents Associations** and have supported a new **leaseholders** group, **Sharrow Surestart** and **Sharrow Community Forum**. Green Party volunteers deliver a quarterly newsletter so people know what we are doing and how to contact us.



Support for permit parking scheme



We support the permit parking scheme, which stops commuter parking. We got the **Club Garden Road** area included,

pushed for a scheme on the **Lansdowne Estate** and successfully campaigned to reduce the cost of permits. We supported residents during the review of the scheme to identify problems.



Road safety on Cemetery Road

Cemetery Road is a busy commuter route. The steep hill, adverse camber and poor surface has led to accidents. **Green**

councillors took up residents' complaints and helped push the council to repair the walls. The road surface has been re-textured to improve the grip.



Tower blocks insulated and refurbished

Green councillors supported residents in the **Leverton Tower blocks** throughout the internal refurbishment (Decent Homes) and the cladding, dealing with problems such as closing in the balconies, blocking the waste chutes and door security. We will now support tenants and residents on the **Lansdowne** and **Hanover** estates during the cladding of the maisonettes.

Bulky waste collection

We asked the Community Assembly to run a "**Bring out your rubbish day**" in the area so that people who can't drive their bulky waste to the Council "dump it" site at Blackstock Road can get it collected for free.

We encouraged **Lansdowne TARA** to organise a skip for the streets near the estate.

We opposed the Labour Government on:

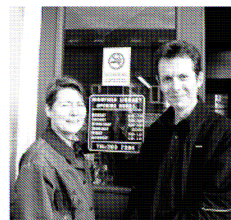
- * Expensive ID card plans
