




# Rawmarsh under threat

Rawmarsh is being threatened by a building boom which will permanently destroy part of our precious local green belt for good. Meanwhile social housing stands empty and in need of repair.

#### **MORE JOBS**

Jobs are vital for communities. We would create jobs and training in public transport, renewable energy and food production. We support local, independent businesses over the corporate giants who often damage the local economy. Closed shops in Rawmarsh show the impact of Parkgate and the big supermarkets.

#### **BETTER PUBLIC TRANSPORT**


To tackle traffic congestion, air pollution and road safety we would prioritise walking, cycling and public transport. We want safer pedestrian routes, more crossings and a 20mph limit on residential roads (excluding major routes).

## BETTER HOUSING AND LOWER BILLS

We believe everyone has the right to housing that is safe, warm, dry and affordable. We would better insulate all housing and offer more energy saving advice. We would fund more posts in Environmental Protection and Licensing to deal with rogue landlords.

#### **NO MORE PRIVATISATION**

We oppose the privatisation of NHS, council and other public services. We believe private firms cost more and offer a poorer service and less democratic control. We would bring in a 'Living Wage' and reduce the gap between the best and worst paid.



#### **STRONGER COMMUNITIES**

We believe good local services are the building blocks of strong, safe communities. We would work with local community groups to listen to their views, get the services they need and make our streets cleaner and safer. We want more support for our local shops, post offices, schools and youth facilities. Without them there will be no local community in Rawmarsh.
