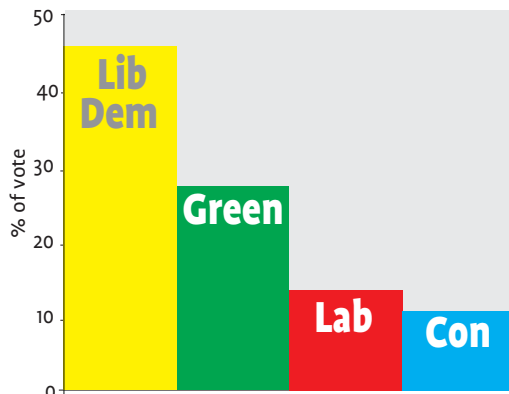

## Green Action in Sheffield

The three Green councillors on Sheffield City Council have:

- Proposed the new night-time noise nuisance service
- Successfully campaigned for powers on bus regulation, to improve services
- Ensured Sheffield opted into the Sustainable Communities Act, to help this area
- Helped fund the South Yorkshire Energy Centre offering energy saving advice
- Initiated the campaign for bus services now available on Boxing Day and New Year's Day
- Increased Council help for small businesses, by settling bills quicker and advertising reduced business rates

## A GREEN VOTE IS FOR

### X MORE JOBS

Jobs are needed in many areas. We would create local jobs and training in manufacturing, public transport, construction and other areas. We support local and independent businesses.

### X BETTER TRANSPORT AND SAFER STREETS

To tackle traffic congestion, pollution and road safety, we support walking, cycling and public transport. We want a free bus service connecting the hospitals, university and the city centre. We've campaigned for new pedestrian crossings and for a 20mph speed limit on residential roads, excluding major routes.

### X STRONGER COMMUNITIES

We support local shops, post offices, and other facilities. We work with local people to listen to their views, get the services they need, and make our neighbourhoods better and more harmonious.

### X BETTER HOUSING AND LOWER FUEL BILLS

Everyone has the right to housing that is safe, warm, dry and affordable. We would help to insulate homes; and offer advice on energy saving and loans for money-saving renewable energy such as solar panels.

### X HIGH-QUALITY PUBLIC SERVICES

Everyone deserves high-quality public services. These should generally be publicly funded and publicly provided, because privatisation can be very poor value for taxpayers. Within Sheffield Council, we'd bring in a 'Living Wage' and reduce the gap between the best and worst paid.

## Green Party action in this ward

We've worked with local residents on many issues recently, such as:

### Road safety, traffic and parking

- Pressing the Council for a 20mph limit on residential roads
- Campaigning for new pedestrian crossings in Broomhill centre and on Manchester and Barber Roads
- A successful campaign against a large car park at the Hallamshire hospital (a campaign not supported by the Lib Dems)
- Pressing successfully for improved parking permit schemes

### Local shops and services

- Campaigning to reinstate post office services in the Crookesmoor area, reminding the Lib Dems of their promise to fight for post offices
- Opposing the proposed Tesco store on Commonsidge
- A successful campaign against Lib Dem cuts to Broomhill library opening hours

### Night-time noise and disturbance

- Addressing various problems in Broomhill, on Ecclesall Road and other areas, such as opposing excessive late-night opening hours
- Campaigning successfully to get the Government to introduce new rules on houses in multiple occupation.
