

Green Action in Sheffield

The Green Party group on Sheffield City Council has:

- Successfully campaigned for powers to bring back Bus Regulation in South Yorkshire.
- Initiated the campaign for bus services now available on Boxing Day and New Year's Day.
- Proposed the new night time noise nuisance service.
- Helped fund the South Yorkshire Energy Centre offering energy saving advice.
- Ensured Sheffield was the first city to opt into the Sustainable Communities Act.
- Increased Council help for small businesses by settling bills quicker and advertising reduced business rates.

MORE JOBS

We would invest in a Green economy creating jobs in public transport, renewable energy and food production. Our economy's dependence on cheap oil is dangerous and short-sighted. Without a radical change in direction climate change and conflicts over diminishing energy resources will escalate, producing mass migrations of people and the tensions and problems such changes cause.



BETTER HOUSING AND LOWER BILLS

We believe everyone has the right to housing that is safe, warm, dry and affordable. We would better insulate all housing, offer more energy saving advice and loans for the installation of money-saving solar panels. We would prioritise truly renewable energy over fossil fuels and nuclear power. Reducing our reliance on energy from often unstable and corrupt governments around the world.



NO MORE PRIVATISATION

We oppose the privatisation of NHS, council and other public services. We believe private firms offer a poorer service, less democratic control and cost more. We oppose private finance deals such as PFI which lock public bodies into long term contracts lasting decades. We would bring in a 'Living Wage' and reduce the gap between the best and worst paid.

STRONGER COMMUNITIES

We believe good local services are the building blocks of strong, safe communities. We would protect and improve local schools, shops and Post Offices. We are fortunate to have the range of shops at Nether Edge crossroads, Sharrowvale Rd and Abbeydale Road available to us. They must be supported and protected from increasing supermarket domination.



BETTER PUBLIC TRANSPORT

To tackle traffic congestion, air pollution and road danger we would prioritise walking, cycling and public transport. We campaigned with local residents to improve the 22 bus service. We want cheaper, Council controlled bus services, more local rail stations and a rail network back in public ownership.


There's only one Green Party
