Fighting to The John Street area still has affordable save jobs at Portland trades, crar Works

Works is a Grade II* listed building with over 30 businesses. We are helping the tenants to fight a planning application for apartments. We collected a petition from residents, attended meetings and helped to involve the press.

Road safety and parking

Green Cllrs working with the local TARA have secured funding for a mini-roundabout and improved crossings on Shoreham Street /



Charlotte Road. We campaigned successfully for a cut in permit prices for the new parking scheme and are supporting residents calling for an early boundary review.

Dropped kerbs for Alderson Rd

Rob Unwin worked with two disabled residents to identify the most important places for dropped kerbs. Green Councillors

made sure they were funded via the Community Assembly. It is now easier to go from Sharrow Lane to Bramall Lane and along Alderson Rd to Lloyds chemist.



Better TV reception

Green Councillors managed to get new TV Aerials for residents on Lancing Road and Shoreham Street where reception had been affected by new building work in the area.
