## 20s plenty on residential roads

We support the national campaign for a 20mph speed limit on residential roads, which would cut accidents, encourage walking and cycling

and only increase car journey times by a few minutes. **Rob Unwin** took a petition to the Community Assembly and Green Councillors included proposals to roll out 20mph zones across the city in their alternative budget.

# Pruning and leaf clearance

Due to the number of mature trees, Streetforce have a hard job keeping up with pruning, tree replacement, leaf clearance and blocked drains. **Rob Unwin** has identified hot



spots and got problems sorted out and we have got trees pruned on Crescent

#### **Permit Parking Problems**

The permit parking zone has caused knock-on effects south of **Sharrow Lane**. In the review, a narrow majority of residents opted to stay out of the scheme but we have dealt with specific

problems. We have supported requests for H-lines across drives, additional yellow-lining on corners and asked the taxi-drivers associations to advise their members to take litter home.
