
## **GREEN STEP FORWARD**

### GREEN ALTERNATIVE TO CUTS



Green MP Caroline Lucas is a voice for radical change in Parliament.

Cuts to vital public services, benefits and pensions are not needed if the government:

- Closes massive tax loopholes
- Gets more people into work
- Cuts Trident nuclear missiles
- Taxes the money markets
- Taxes bank profits and cuts bonuses

Greens say create 1 million new jobs by investing in renewable energy, public transport and housing. Scrap tuition fees and reinstate the Educational Maintenance Allowance – free education for all, rich or poor.

- The only party campaigning on alternatives to government cuts

### **X** STRONG COMMUNITIES

Good local facilities and support for voluntary groups, not cuts to public services, are the only way to build the "big society". We support local schools, community groups and campaigns, and engage in genuine consultation, bringing people together to make their voices heard.

#### **X** TUITION FEES, PAY & BENEFITS

Education benefits society so tuition fees and EMA (Educational Maintenance Allowance) should be funded from general tax, not loans or a graduate tax. The gap between rich and poor should be smaller and unemployed, elderly and disabled people should have decent benefits and services.

## **X** SECURE HOUSING

We want long-term, secure tenancies. We would bring Sheffield Homes back into the council and enforce better standards in private rented accommodation. We support investment in repairs, energy saving and renewable energy for all homes.

## X SAFER STREETS

Too many cars mean congestion, pollution and accidents. We want money spent where traffic is worst, a city wide 20mph limit on residential roads and higher priority for pedestrian and cycle routes (including winter gritting).

#### **X**RE-USE, REPAIR, RECYCLE

The Lib Dems and Labour locked Sheffield into a 35 year contract with profit-driven Veolia, to incinerate our waste. Despite this, we support projects to reduce waste and maximise jobs through re-use, repair and recycling.





## **GREEN ACTION** & INFLUENCE

In Sheffield two Green Councillors have made a real difference by forcing the Council to adopt a living wage policy, committing to 20mph zones and improving recycling. In Gleadless Valley ward Greens have been active in :

- Supporting residents getting new play equipment in Meersbrook Park
- Installing traffic calming measures
- Campaigning against damaging planning applications
- Sorting out potholes, broken bins, blocked gullies and overgrown trees
- Arguing for more funding for tree planting in the area
- Securing funding for the South Yorkshire Energy Centre at Heeley City Farm
- Helping bring The Bean (a kickabout area) back into use
