
Broomhill ward election result 2011







Candidate profile: Bernard Little Broomhill ward candidate

I am 57, married and have lived in Broomhill since 1986. I work as a therapy assistant at the Hallamshire Hospital and was a Green Councillor in Central ward from 2006-2010. Many of you will have spoken to me as I knock on doors throughout the year.

The village feel of Ecclesall Road, Broomhill and Crookesmoor is being eroded. Building local communities that engage with everyone is

much more challenging with fewer long term residents. Other parties in power make things worse; the economy isn't recovering, the environment is deteriorating, communities are more divided and cuts hit the most vulnerable the hardest.



GREEN ACTION

Green Councillors have offered real alternatives eg:

- · Help for people most affected by moving to fortnightly bin collections


Our council budget proposals tried to cut backroom functions and top executive salaries to support frontline services like Citizen's Advice and the Youth Service. Plus raise standards in private-rented housing and stop cuts to teams fighting anti-social behaviour. But we were voted down by Labour and the Lib Dems.



Locally, Bernard Little pressed for action that corrected meter faults which denied shoppers 15 minutes free parking across the area. He highlighted poor air quality on Ecclesall Road and at Broomhill Shopping Centre – a Broomhill Forum conference on mitigating air pollution was held on April 21st.
