DEAL

**SCRAP**

### **GREEN ACTION**



Cllr Rob Murphy and Cllr Jillian Creasy (above) have made the Council:

- install pedestrian crossings and road safety measures
- run a citywide bus service on Boxing and New Year's Day
- fund a Ranger post to look after local parks
- improve plans for the new youth centre on Lowfield

In the Green's Council budget this year we tried to cut the wages of top executives and instead support:

- · citizens' advice centres
- Sharrow Sure Start
- the private sector housing standards team But our proposals were voted down by the ruling Labour councillors
