


Should you vote green?

How and where to vote: Follow these instructions to vote in both Council and European Parliament elections on Thursday, May 22nd.

You must be registered to vote by May 7th. Paper forms are at www.sheffield.gov.uk/your-city-council/elections. Students are allowed to register to vote in council elections at both home and term-time addresses. If you're registered, you will receive a polling card by post shortly before the election. It tells you where to vote. Polling stations are open from **7am until 10pm** on Thursday May 22nd. You don't need to bring your polling card or ID with you to vote.
