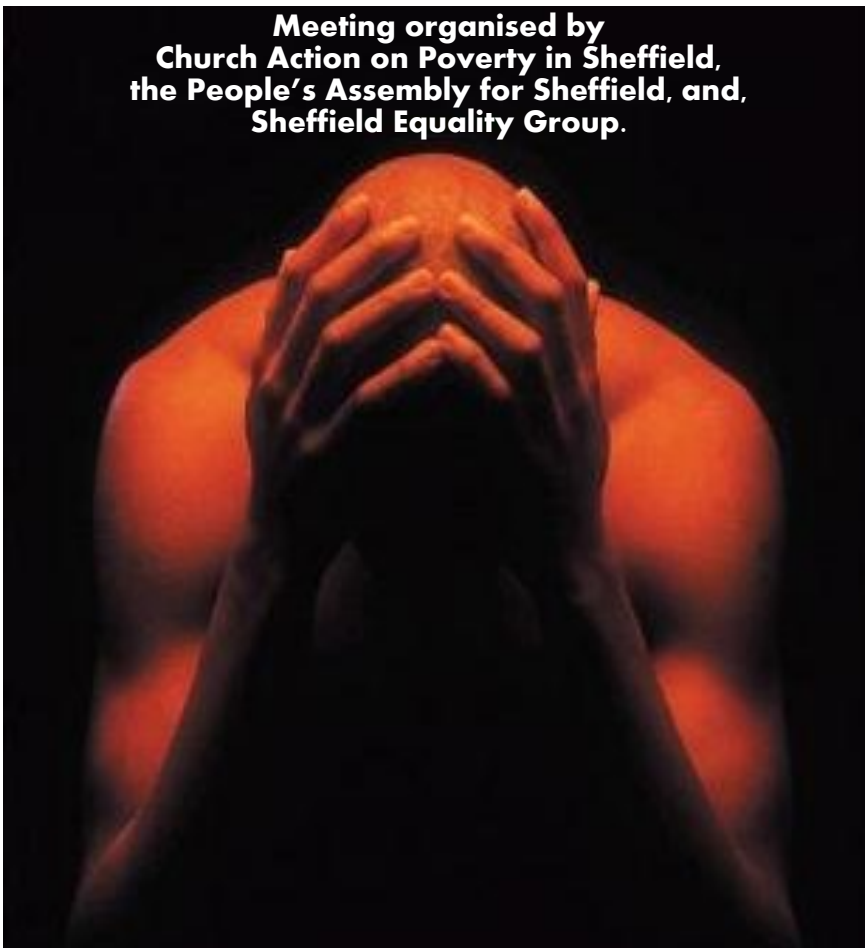


POVERTY IN SHEFFIELD TODAY
