ONE YEAR OF VOLUNTEER-RUN LIBRARIES



In September 2014 the Labour-controlled Council handed over responsibility for running many libraries to volunteers. **Clir Brian Webster** comments "The hard work and dedication of dozens of local people keeps **Broomhill Community Library** open for 33 hours a week. Our focus as ward councillors is on ensuring that library groups get the Council support needed to ensure the long-term future and sustainability of these vital community spaces."

STRONG GREEN SUPPORT IN MAY ELECTIONS



Aodan Marken was elected as the second Broomhill ward Green councillor in May – joining **Cllr Brian Webster**. In Sheffield Central parliamentary constituency, **Jillian Creasy** came second behind Labour, with a quadrupled Green vote from 2010.

If Parliament approves, you will be in a new **Broomhill & Sharrow Vale** council ward from May 2016. The **Springfield Estate**, **Broomhall** and **Sharrow Vale** areas are due to move in to this ward. All 84 councillors will have to stand for re-election – you will have 3 votes to elect 3 councillors next May.

YOUNG GREENS LIVING WAGE FOCUS

Young Greens groups at both Universities are campaigning on electoral reform and the living wage. Green Party activist Magid Mah, former President of the University of Hull Students' Union, said: "Greens supported the strong campaign that led to the **University of Sheffield Students Union** agreeing to pay core staff the living wage. But we continue to press for a living wage for all university staff, and a maximum 10:1 pay ratio between the highest and lowest paid staff on campus." DEVOLUTION WITHOUT DEMOCRACY

A secret deal made behind closed doors with contempt for the views of the public. That's the devolution deal for Sheffield City Region negotiated by leaders of 9 (mainly Labour run) councils who announced it alongside George Osborne. 65% voted against an elected mayor in Sheffield in 2012 but we are still getting one. The deal brings just an extra £30 million a year to Sheffield – just over 2% of the current council budget of £1391 million.

FLATS PLAN REFUSED



Green Clir Aodan Marken ioined local residents and the **Broomhall Park Association** in successfully objecting to plans for a twelve-storey block of flats and shops at the current **Bamboo Lounge** site on **Ecclesall Rd** close to Summerfield St. Cllr Marken said: "This site needs development but plans need to be scaled down with design improvements so that officers can recommend approval."

STREET TREE DEBATE **CONTINUES**

The felling of roadside trees by highways contractor Amey continues to draw protests across Sheffield. Green Cllr Brian Webster said: "Local people want all alternatives properly considered before healthy trees are felled, but the Labour Council just isn't listening. Private Finance Initiative schemes, like the Streets Ahead contract, make council services less accountable. They are hugely expensive with repayments increasing year on year."
